

PORTFOLIO COMMENTARY

The Global Growth Portfolio returned -0.6% in September, taking 2020 returns so far to -1.8%. September saw a modest correction in global equities following a strong market recovery since the end of March, with US technology stocks giving back some of the gains of recent months. US equities fell by 3.9% in local currency terms, although UK investors benefited from a depreciation in the Pound, boosting returns in overseas assets.

Our strongest performer last month was the Evenlode Global Income fund, which returned 2.8% and outperformed its global benchmark by 2.6%. This income focused strategy benefited from a preference for quality businesses with a relatively low allocation to technology stocks. We also saw good results from the Lyrical fund, which returned 1.1% against a market that was 0.3% down. The manager's value-bias approach suffered in the first quarter of the year but has benefited from a recovery in the more cyclically sensitive sectors of the US market. Our weakest performer during the period was the GLG Undervalued Assets fund, which underperformed by 5.4%. This strategy emphasises contrarian ideas in the UK market and has suffered from depressed investor sentiment.

ACTIVE MANAGER IN FOCUS

The **Findlay Park American Fund** invests in large and mega-cap US equities, focusing on their cash flow generation and profit sustainability. Top holdings currently include Microsoft, T-Mobile and Amazon. At a sector level, the manager favours Healthcare, Communucations and Financials and avoids Utilities and Real Estate. In recent months the fund has maintained an elevated cash balance reflecting the manager's cautious outlook. Over the long term the team have delivered strong outperformance of the US market and followed a disciplined process and philosophy that remains in place today.
